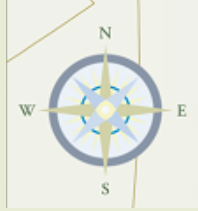

SENECA PARK

Seneca Park was the last of the parks designed in Louisville by the Olmsted firm. The plan, presented in 1928, was in stark contrast to neighboring Cherokee Park because of its formal style and also because the plan included an 18-hole golf course along with many other recreation facilities.
