1 TRAIL DONOR KIOSK

Interpretive panel explains trail, overlooks site of 1880's train station.

2 INDIAN POINT PARK

Public park with beach access and picnic tables.

3 PAGAN POINT NATURE PRESERVE

Nature Trust of New Brunswick. Forested trail to the beach and along the shore.

4 ST. ANDREWS SALT MARSH

A constantly-changing saltwater pond, formed by a barrier beach along the shore.

5 O'NEILL SALT MARSH

The 7m (25ft) incoming tide floods this twice daily.

6 RAMP TO BEACH

Best used when the tide is at least halfway out. Take care to return to the trail before the beach floods on the rising tide!

7 KATY'S COVE

A sun-warmed saltwater swimming area created by the Algonquin Hotel in 1906. At beach access on east side, beware of strong undertow at control gates. Trail passes Katy's Cove swimming beach on west side.

8 ST. ANDREWS RURAL CEMETERY

Incorporated 1856. Notable people from Canada's history are buried in the far corners.

9 TIDAL ROAD TO MINISTERS ISLAND

Passable at half tide and lower; see tide schedule. Van Horne Estate and an extensive trail network on the Island.
