Discover the forest's battlefield landmarks and pagan traditions at the infamous Prisoner's Stone and St Mary's Well, a local 'cloutie well'.

How to get here

From Inverness, take the A96 towards Aberdeen and after about 1 mile (1.6 km) take the 2nd roundabout exit towards Balloch, Culloden and Smithton. At the second set of traffic lights turn right towards Culloden Moor and Croy. The car park is on your left after ¼ mile (400 metres).

Please note:

St Mary's Well is an older site, a traditional cloutie well. Dipping a clout (rag) in the well and tying it to a tree is said to bring good luck. Please choose biodegradable material for your clout!
